

**Invitation  
for  
Expression of Interest  
to form part of the  
Registration Board (2026–2028)  
of the Professional Architects' Council**

The Professional Architects' Council (PAC) hereby invites **eligible registered architects** to submit their Expression of Interest to form part of the **Registration Board (RB)** for the period **2026–2028**.

### **Legal Basis**

In accordance with **Paragraph 9 of the Professional Architects' Council Act 2011 (as amended in 2021)**, the Registration Board is established to assist the Council in determining applications for registration as professional architects.

The Registration Board shall consist of:

- **One Chairperson**
- **Two Assessors**

These members shall be appointed by the Council on such terms and conditions as it may determine, subject to subsection (3) of the Act.

### **Eligibility Criteria**

Applicants must be:

- Professional architects with **at least 15 years' experience** in practice.
- **Of good character, with no conviction for offences involving fraud or dishonesty** in any country.

## **Composition**

A list of **five Architects** will be retained to constitute the Registration Board, as follows:

- **Three Members**
- **Two Alternate Members**

## **Duties of the Registration Board**

Members of the Registration Board will be responsible for:

1. **Examining and verifying applications** referred by the Registrar for registration as Professional Architect, ensuring compliance with the PAC Act 2011 (amended 2021).
2. **Setting interview dates** in consultation with the Registrar.
3. **Conducting interviews** (maximum of three applicants per session), assessing applicants' performance, and submitting recommendations accordingly.

## **Remuneration**

Members will be remunerated at the rate of **Rs 2000 per sitting**.

## **Submission of Interest**

Professional Architects meeting the above criteria, willing to form part of the Registration Board, are invited to **complete and submit the attached Expression of Interest form by latest 6<sup>th</sup> February 2026 at 16.00 hours**.
